If the FOIA Coordinator knows or has reason to know that all or a portio of the requested information is available on its website, the Road Commission must notify the requester in its written response that all or a portion of the requested information is available on the website. The written response, to the degree practicable in the specific instance, must include a specific webpage address where the requested information is available. On the detailed cost itemization form, the Road Commission must separate the requested public records that are available on its website from those that are not available on the website and must inform the requester of the additional charge to receive copies of the public records that are available on its website.

If the Road Commission has included the website address for a record in its written response to the requester and the requester thereafter stipulates that the public record be provided to him or her in a paper format (if the Road Commission has the technological capability) but may use a fringe benefit multiplier greater than the 50%, not to exceed the actual costs of providing the information in the specified format.

(i) The individual has previously received discounted copies of public records from the same public body twice during that calendar year,

(ii) The individual requests the information in conjunction with outside parties who are offering or providing payment or other remuneration to the individual to make the request. A public body may require a statement by the requester in the affidavit that the reqest is not being made in conjunction with outside parties in exchange for payment or other remuneration.
